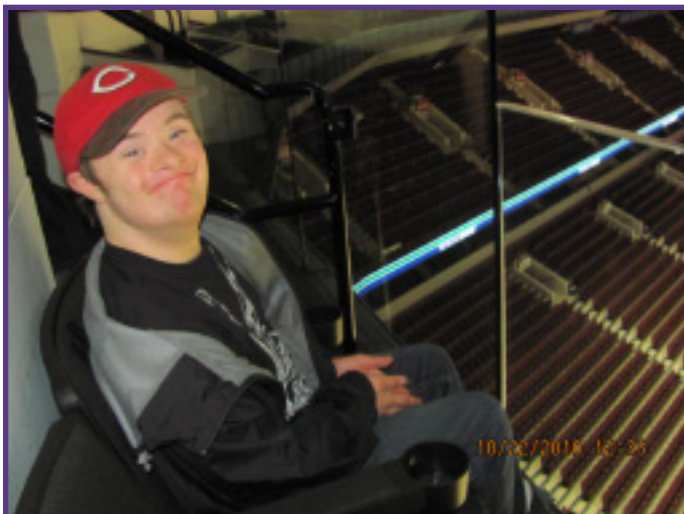

#### How do I register?

#### When I register online where do I go and what do I do?

When you visit our web site scroll down to the bottom left hand side of the web page and click on the icon that says, "Register for Rec & Leisure Winter/ Spring Programs." When you click on this icon it will take you to the registration page. Once there, you will be asked to enter your child's first and last name, birth date, your full name, address, phone number and email. You will then skip to the registration page where you check off which activities you are interested in signing up for. Registering for these classes and clubs does not guarantee a spot, it just lets us know that you are interested in signing up.

#### What if I am unavailable to access a computer at 9:30 in the morning of registration or if I am unable to come to Semiahmoo House Society to register my child?

Anyone can register your child, whether it be online or in-person.

#### Once I've filled out the registration, how do I pay?

Please note that registration does not mean that you have a space in that class/club/camp/Trip. Registration simply indicates that you are interested in signing up for the indicated program. NO payment is due until you have received confirmation via email. Email will indicate if your child is registered or wait listed.

#### Can I pre-register my child?

To ensure fairness to all, we are unable to accept pre-registration. There are NO exceptions.

#### When do I find out if my child is in the classes I signed up for?

Confirmation will be sent via email no later than 4:00 p.m Jan 4.

#### My child has never attended Rec & Leisure before, how do I access more information?

Please contact Rec & Leisure at 604 536 1242 ext255 or [Rec.Leisure@shsbc.ca](mailto:Rec.Leisure@shsbc.ca) prior to registration.

To ensure the suitability of our programs for your child, you must have an orientation to the program and to the Society.

#### Payments/Cancellation

Please note that once you are registered in the classes/clubs/camps/trips, we will accept cancellation up to and no less than 7 days prior to the start date to ensure we fill the vacant spot with someone on the wait list. No refund will be issued if you cancel after 7 days.

#### Illness

If your child is absent during any of our classes/clubs/camps/trips due to illness, family vacations, or other reasons, it is necessary to pay the full fee as we staff our programs according to the numbers registered.

### Staff Ratio

Recreation & Leisure Services bases its prices on a 3:1 ratio in our Out of School Care programs, and a 5:1 ratio for our Adapted Classes/Clubs/Trips. Please contact us prior to registration if you feel your child requires additional support.

## District Wide Pro DAZE Camp.

Parents asked and we responded... if you need care for your teenager on District Wide Professional Days, we are offering day camps 4 of the 6 Pro Days for the 2010/2011 school year.

After Skool Kool will continue to run on District Wide Professional Days. Parents may choose to put their child in the regular day 9:00 - 3:00 (\$39.00) and their fee for ASK (\$19.50) will cover the extended day until 5:30 p.m.

**After Skool Kool** is an out of school care program that provides a safe and nurturing environment for youth with developmental disabilities between the ages of 13 - 19. The program strives to support the development of social skills, life skills, and community access through recreational, leisure and social activities. While doing this, we are ensuring that we provide a creative and enjoyable atmosphere that encourages each person to develop to their fullest potential. Among some of After Skool Kool's activities are community excursions, art, dance, games and visiting places like the SPCA and the Post Office.

After Skool Kool is offered Monday to Friday from 3:00 - 5:30 p.m. for teens ages 13 -19. After Skool Kool provides transportation from the 3 local high schools (Elgin, Earl Marriot, and Semiahmoo Secondary).

After Skool Kool is also offered for kids ages 9 - 12 on Mondays. Please note that parents/caregivers of this age group (9-12) must provide their own transportation to the program.

**Semiahmoo House Society's Rec and Leisure program was able to purchase an 18-seat, wheelchair-accessible van thanks to a \$30,000 donation from Westminster Savings.**

**"Our program has grown even larger because of the bus," program manager Julie Kolstrup said in a release. "There are now three additional spaces for participants, which mean fewer people on the wait lists and more people benefitting.**

**"This is yet another example of how our community values our service and efforts, and the people we support."**

**Semiahmoo House supports individuals and families challenged with developmental disabilities, and its Rec and Leisure program allows participants to have fun, make friends and learn new things.**

**The van offers greater community involvement and opportunities, especially for people with more severe disabilities who may not have access to integrated programs unless supports are available, the release states.**

**Its purchase was made possible by Westminster Savings and other community donations.**

**"Everyone that has seen or been on the bus thinks it's great," Kolstrup. "Staff report that it is more like a charter bus than a real bus, it's a pleasure to drive and the wheelchair lift is very easy to use. In addition, because the interior is a flat surface, those with mobility issues can navigate to their seats with ease and confidence."**
